

SMOKE-FREE MULTI-UNIT HOUSING RECOGNITION APPLICATION

In accordance with a Resolution passed by the City of Sacramento on April 7, 2009, multi-unit housing with a **minimum of 50% of existing units designated as non-smoking, including private patios and balconies**, will receive a certificate and public recognition. The City of Sacramento Code Enforcement Department and the Sacramento County Chronic Disease Prevention Program will implement this award process.

TO BE ELGIBLE FOR THIS AWARD:

- ***YOUR APARTMENT COMMUNITY MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 50% EXISTING UNITS SET ASIDE AS NON-SMOKING***
- ***YOUR APARTMENT COMMUNITY MUST BE LOCATED WITHIN THE SACRAMENTO CITY LIMITS;***
- ***A LEASE OR RENTAL AGREEMENT OR AN ADDENDUM MUST BE ATTACHED TO THIS APPLICATION INDICATING THE NO SMOKING RESTRICTION***
